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Introduction: GEAR UP Achieve, an initiative led by Auburn University, aims to increase the number of low-income students significantly prepared to enter and succeed in postsecondary education. We seek information from qualified contractors and vendors to provide programming for 8th to 9th-grade students, families, teachers, and communities. More information can be found at https://auburn.edu/academic/gearup/. Contracts will be awarded for services valued at \$75,000 or below.

Program Goals: The educational programming should align with the following goals of GEAR UP Achieve:

- 1. Provide access to rigorous coursework that prepares students for postsecondary education (PSE).
- 2. Assist students in completing critical steps for PSE.
- 3. Implement an advising program to support PSE aspirations.
- 4. Increase funding awareness and help navigate financial aid.

Services: We expect proposals to include providing services to one or more of the 7 GEAR UP Achieve regions and each school. We are interested in services that include, but are not limited to:

- Character development
- Importance of school attendance
- Healthy relations
- Conflict management
- Mentoring
- Literacy and math tutoring
- Essay and writing programs
- STEM/STEAM workshops
- Coding and innovation
- College awareness preparation
- Tours and events
- Teacher professional workshops and out of school time aligned with the

Alabama state standards and GUA goals

- Career interest advising and surveys
- Financial aid advising
- Family engagement
- Workshops around career trades certifications, college scholarship applications, ACT test prep, FAFSA, dual enrollment
- College tours and fairs
- Career planning events
- Health and wellness workshops

2.	Quality and relevance of services offered.	10%
3.	Data tracking and sharing timelines.	10%
4.	Experience and qualifications of the provider.	10%
5.	Cost-effectiveness of the proposed budget.	50%
6.	Positive references and past performance.	10%
